DON & ELLIE KNAUSS VETERAN RESOURCE & SUPPORT CENTER

The VRSC provides current Texas A&M students who **previously served** or are **currently serving in the US military** with proprietary and partnered programming that **facilitates student success from application to vocation**. Our programs fill gaps and navigate obstacles that threaten degree completion, cultivate the Aggie Spirit, and promote student engagement.

- ▶ Offers 195 scholarships for veteran & military-affiliated students
- ▶ Home to the *VRSC Textbook Library*, saving nearly \$1 million in textbook costs for veteran, military students, and dependents
- ▶ 60% of veteran students are supporting a family while enrolled
- ▶ 60% of veteran students are enrolled in graduate or professional programs
- ▶ 30% of veteran students are still serving as Active Duty, Guard, or Reserve

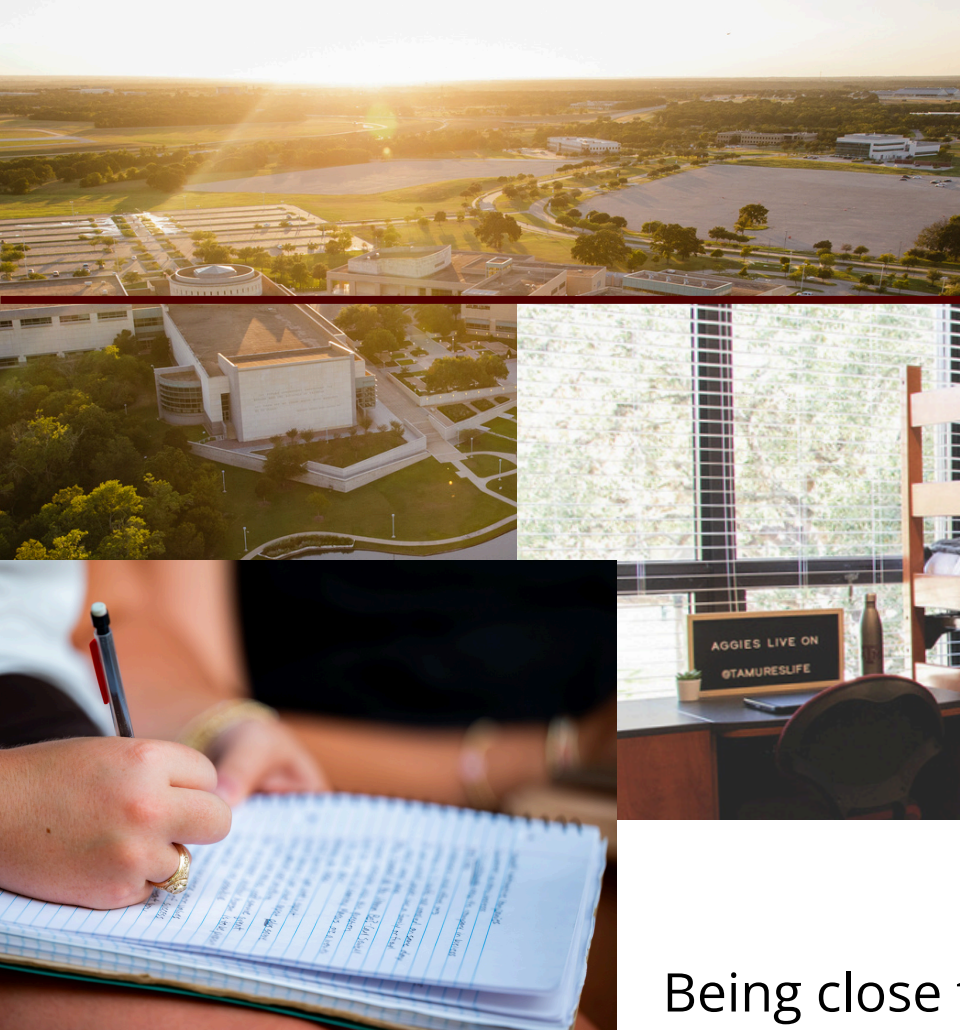

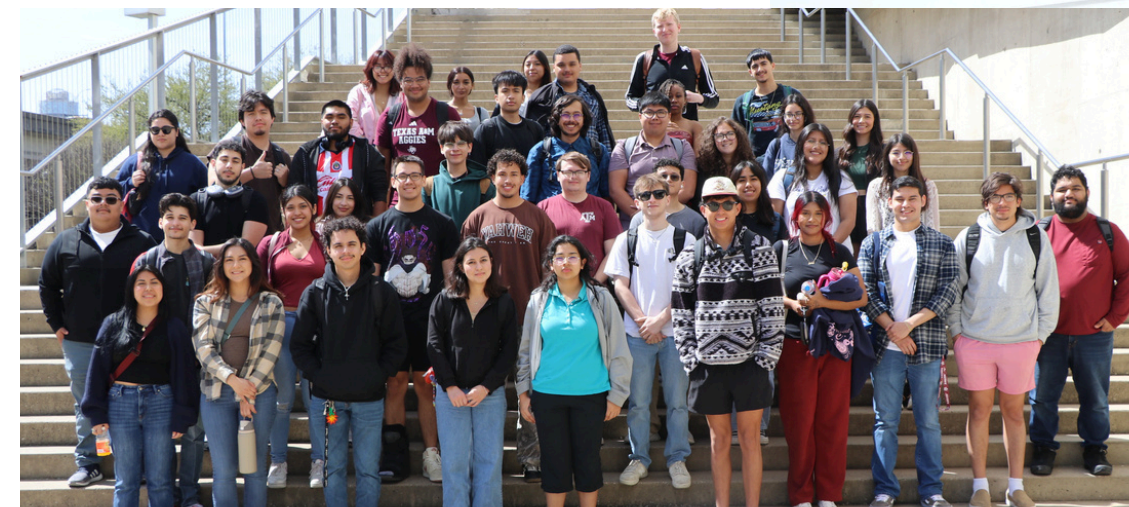
